A major opportunity. Students have the opportunity to study with world renowned music professors. Many members of the Department of Music faculty perform frequently in the region and are members of prestigious performing organizations such as the Columbus Symphony Orchestra and Opera Columbus.

Performance platforms. Whether it's part of the wind ensemble, Cardinal marching band, jazz ensemble, Opera Theatre, or one of six vocal ensembles, Otterbein offers performance opportunities on and off campus. In the past several years, performance groups have traveled to China, Ireland and Germany to provide students international performance opportunities.

Small class size. With an average 12-to-1 student to faculty ratio, students benefit from individualized attention. Most music classes are held in the Battelle Fine Arts Center (BFAC) with access to numerous class and rehearsal rooms, a keyboard lab, computer lab, an electronic music studio, and Riley Auditorium, a 260-seat recital hall.

NEW SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Otterbein University is offering a new scholarship opportunity, the **Young Artist Scholarship**, for music majors. This **\$30,000** competitive scholarship will go to up to five recipients per year and is renewable for four years (eight semesters) for music majors in good standing, maintaining a 3.0 GPA.

The application deadline is Dec. 15, 2017. Completed music audition due by Feb. 20, 2018.
