PROCEDURES FOR APPLICATION:

1. In writing, typewritten, state your present plans for college attendance, probable major, your contribution to Rich Central High School in academic, non-scholastic, athletic participation, or to the total program of the school. Also, state any personal reasons for applying for the scholarship, such as financial need.

There is no need for a complete financial statement but it would be helpful to make a statement about the costs expected vs. the available sources, plus a listing of any financial aid already received (including scholarships).

Some information about family size, number of children in college, and special money commitments should also be included.

2. Two letters of teacher recommendation must be directed to Mr. Schmidt.
3. Final deadline for submitting applications is **April 28, 2017 by 3:15 p.m.**
4. Awarding of the scholarship will be based on:
 - a. The scholarship shall go to a person who is intending to become a teacher. The recipient shall have declared that as a major or intended major to be eligible for monetary award.
 - b. First consideration of the scholarship award shall be to children of RTHSEA members attending the campus awarding the scholarship.
 - c. Secondary consideration shall be given to non-members of RTHSEA who are planning to enter the teaching profession.
 - d. If no person applying for the scholarship expresses an interest in entering the teaching profession, the scholarship shall be awarded to the most deserving candidate in any field of study. First consideration of the scholarship award shall be given to children of RTHSEA members attending the campus awarding the scholarship.

In your letter of application please state if any of the above criterion apply to you.

THE RECIPIENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT THE AWARDS EVENING ON MAY 17.
