The Kappa 1st Foundation scholarships targets primarily African American males. In order to qualify for consideration of award students must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Must be a graduating high school senior
- 2. Must have been accepted to a 4-year college or university
- 3. Have at least 2.5 cumulative GPA on 4.0 scale.
- 4. Application must be filled out and submitted by May 1, 2017.
- 5. Scholarship application and criteria needs to be submitted, along with all official documents needed to qualify for award.
