**A nutritious FREE breakfast and lunch will be available to ALL children. NO PROOF OF INCOME REQUIRED. ANYONE UNDER AGE 18 EATS FREE Your children do not have to attend this school district to participate in the Summer Feeding Program!**

Adults can purchase the same meals - \$2.00 for breakfast and \$3.00 for lunch each day.
