

## Dr. Donna Simpson Leak Sample of Significant Accomplishments



1. Served as Math Department Chair and integral part of Homewood-Flossmoor High Schools Blue Ribbon Status.
2. Served in Corporate America as a Marketing Executive, accountable for increasing revenue through marketing efforts. Created significant increases in sales through specific marketing each year.
3. Raised test scores in mathematics from the 2006 – 2007 school year to the 2008 – 2009 school year by close to 14% for all students, close to 14% for African American Students and 21% for economically disadvantaged. Saw gains during this same time period at one of the high schools of over 32% for all students, close to 34% for African American students, and close to 42% for economically disadvantaged students.
4. Raised test scores in reading from the 2006 – 2007 school year to the 2008 – 2009 school year by 11% for all students, close to 10% for African American Students and close to 17% for economically disadvantaged. Saw gains during this same time period at one of the high schools of close to 25% for all students, over 25% for African American students, and close to 35% for economically disadvantaged students.
5. Campus named to the US News and World Report as one of the top 1500 in the nation for 2010 and earned 2009 Illinois Honor Roll Status.
6. Raised test scores in an inner city urban school from 16% meets/exceeds state standards to 62% meets/exceeds in a three year window.
7. Served on the National Board of Directors for the National Council of Supervisors of mathematics for the past 11 years providing valuable input to the National Math Panel and the upcoming Common Core Standards.
8. Created a data and information driven decision making process at every level - K – 12 - consistently centered around student achievement
