Rich Township High School District 227 Transition Program provides a coordinated set of activities for students between the ages of 18 and 22, designed within an outcome-oriented process that promotes movement from high school to post school activities, including postsecondary education, vocational training, integrated employment (including supported employment), continuing and adult education, adult services, independent living, or community participation.
