Advanced Placement Exams are rapidly approaching. As your child continues to prepare for the exam(s) in their AP course(s), we want communicate the District expectations. All AP students are expected to sit for all of the AP Exams for the AP courses they are enrolled. The district will cover the entire cost of the AP exams for the 2020-21 school year. All students will be required to take the paper/pencil version of their AP Exam(s) on campus. The table below shows the date, time, and AP exam. **The STEM campus will host ALL AP Exams (3600 W. 203rd St.).**

AP Exam FAQs

1. If I am in an AP course, do I have to sit for the exam?

Yes. The expectation of the district is that all students enrolled in Advanced Placement (AP) courses must sit for the AP exam.

2. How much money does an AP exam cost?

The College Board charges \$95 per exam.

3. How much am I required to pay?

Rich Township High School District 227 will cover 100% of the exam fees for all students taking AP exams.

4. What happens if I do not sit for the AP exam?

If a student does not sit for the exam, the AP course weight will not be applied and have a negative impact on the overall Grade Point Average (GPA).
